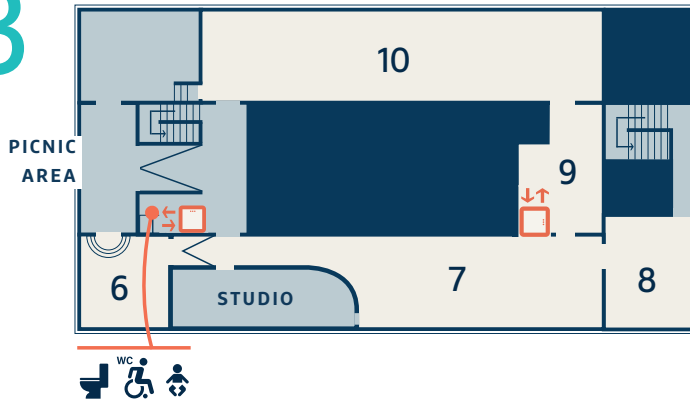

Steer both small and large boats as a captain. Note the over 13-year-old limit. Closes one hour before the museum.

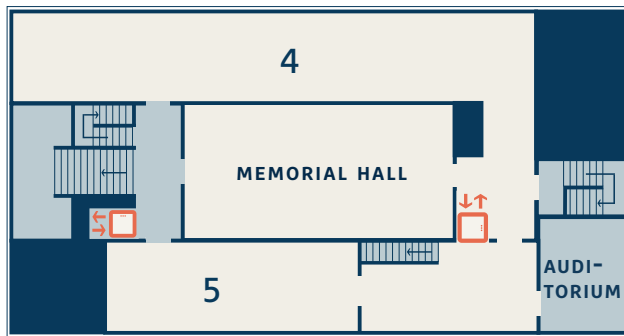
7. Big Blue

Children's exhibition (4–10 years) which awakens love for the sea through different senses.

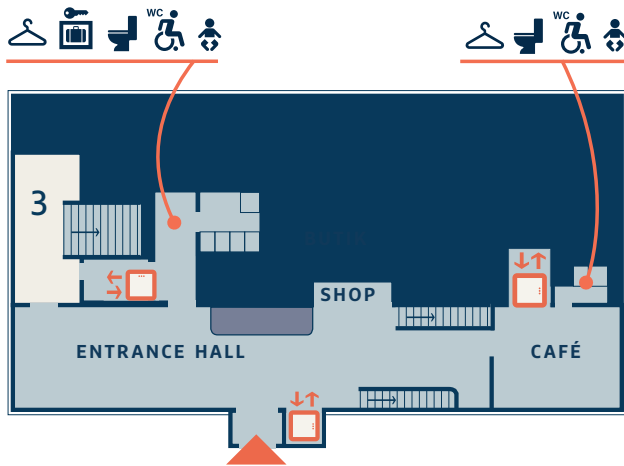
6. Knattegatt – Toddlers playroom

4. Sea of Stories

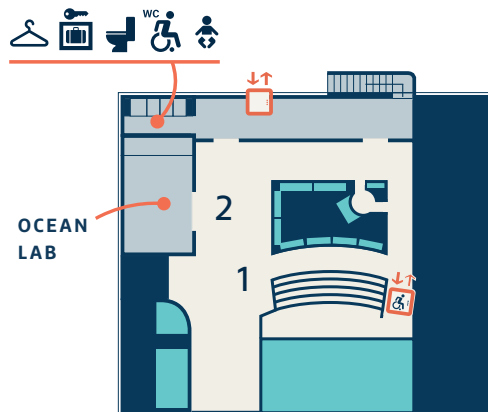
Meet the people who travelled the ocean during the last 400 years through hundreds of their authentic objects, photos and real testimonies.
